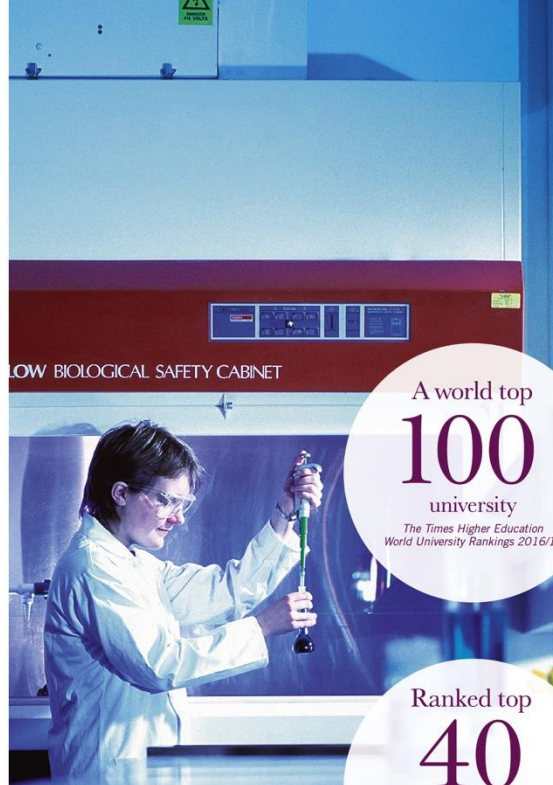

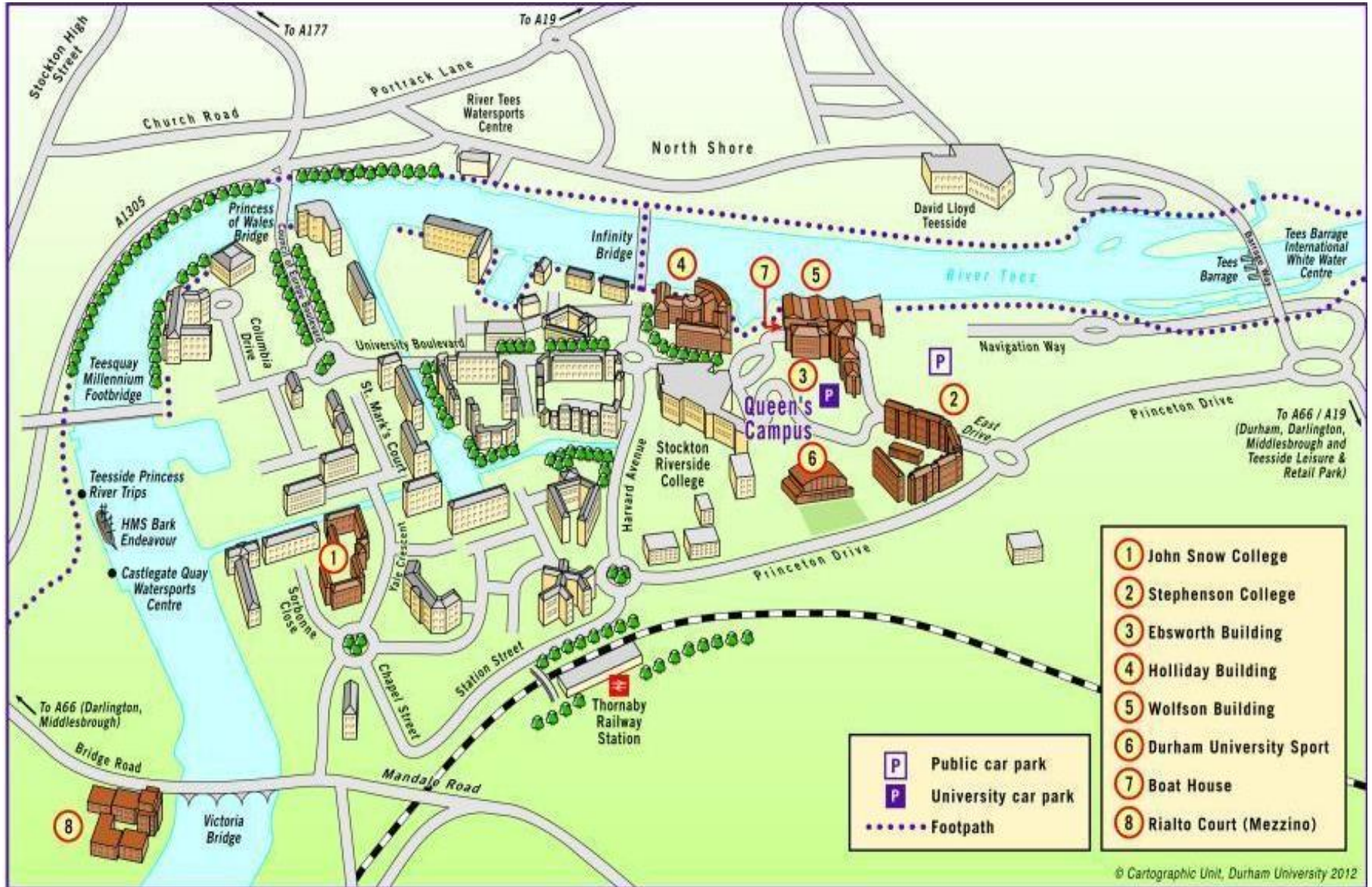

Accommodation

If you have confirmed your place on the course, you need to find accommodation. Our Accommodation Team will contact you and guide you through the process.

- Rialto Court, close to Stockton town centre, yet only 10-15 minutes walk from Campus.
- En-suite rooms in apartments of varied size with shared kitchens equipped with dishwashers and televisions.

Students should confirm their place, apply for accommodation and complete all the relevant steps by July 31st, 2017 to have the option of a room at Rialto Court.

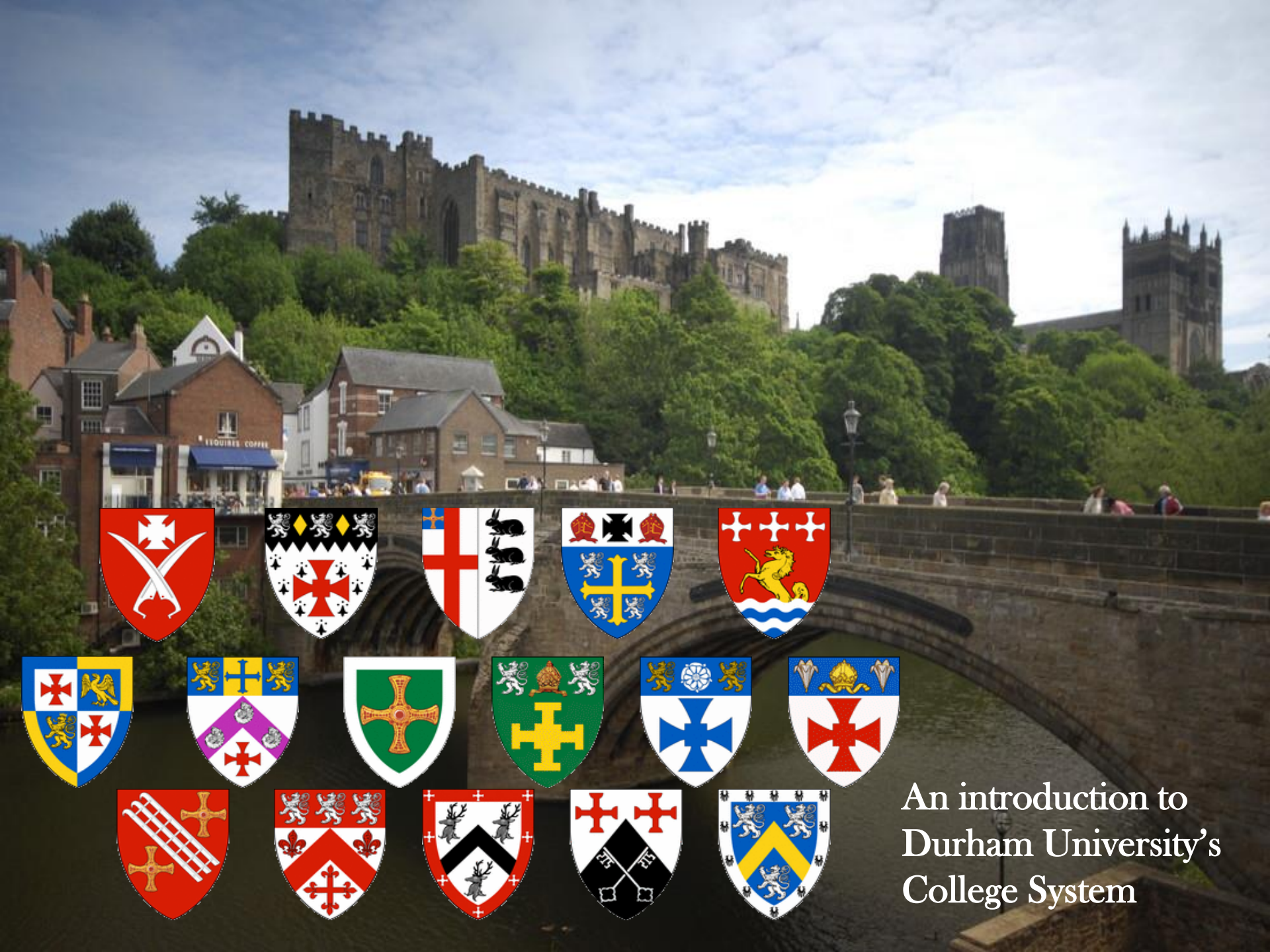
