




### Why choose Durham University?



- En-suite rooms in apartments of varied size with shared kitchens equipped with dishwashers and televisions.


Students should confirm their place, apply for accommodation and complete all the relevant steps by July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2017 to have the option of a room at Rialto Court.

### What's it like at Durham City?


Take advantage of the free bus service between Queen's Campus and Durham City and discover this UNESCO World Heritage site, and a small, friendly city.

- Cafes, restaurants and shopping











### World Class Facilities
